

All State Selection Process

All State Football

- 1. 6 divisions: “S”, “SS”, “M”, “MM”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. a. All coaches vote for 11 offensive and 11 defensive players plus 1 punter and 1 kicker for each division totaling 24 players in each division.**
 - b. All State chairperson will get the ballots and the committee will tabulate them**

Girls All-State Volleyball

- 1. 3 divisions: “Small”, “Medium”, “Large”**
- 2. a. Coaches vote by ballots returned to chairperson.**
 - b. Volleyball committee tabulates the votes**
- 3. The top nine players (by votes) in each division are classified as All- State players.**

Boys All-State Volleyball

- 1. 2 divisions: “L”, “M”**
- 2. Coaches vote on line**
- 3. Each coach who votes must vote for 6 players in a division.**
- 4. Votes are tabulated**
- 5. Top 9 vote getters per division receive All-State honors.**

Girls All-State Swimming

- 1. 4 division: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. In each division the top three finishes in each individual event and the top two finishes in each relay at the divisional finals will make All-State.**

Boys All-State Swimming

- 1. 4 division : “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. In each division the top three finishes in each individual event and the top two finishes in each relay at the divisional finals will make All-State.**

All-State Field Hockey

- 1. 3 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”**
- 2. a. All field hockey coaches can vote for All-State selections**
b. Chairperson of All-State collects the ballots and the committee tabulates them
c. Field Hockey All-State teams in each division will consist of one goalie plus the top 15 vote receivers.

Boys and Girls Cross Country

- 1. 6 divisions: “S”, “SS”, “M”, “MM”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. The top eight winners in each division is your All-State team plus any runner who finishes in the top 25 in the State Open who was not included in #1.**

Boys and Girls All-State Soccer

- 1. 4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. Coaches in each league meet to select the best players in their league. All selected players are then ranked from 1 to 22. The top 11 players in most leagues are designated all league. These rankings are forwarded to the All-State committee. From all league ranking sheets the committee considers all the top players in each league. The top 22 players in each classification are selected as the All—State teams in each division. This consists of 20 field players and two goalkeepers.**

Boys All-State Basketball

- 1. 4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. Coaches vote by ballot**
- 3. Boys basketball committee tabulate the votes**
- 4. The top eight vote receivers in each division are classified as All-State players.**

Girls All-State Basketball

- 1. 4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. Coaches vote by ballot**
- 3. Ballots are sent to girls All-State Chairperson**
- 4. Girls basketball committee tabulates the votes**
- 5. The top eight vote receivers in each division are classified as girls All-State players**

All-State Ice Hockey

- 1. 2 divisions: Division I , Division II**
- 2. Coaches will be able to select 1 goalie, 2 defense men, 3 forwards and the next six highest vote receivers, totaling 12 in each division.**
- 3. All ballots will be returned to ice hockey chairperson to be tabulated by the committee.**

All-State Wrestling

- 1. 4 division: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. Each divisional champion winner per weight class is All-State. That is fourteen winners in each division.**

Boys and Girls Indoor All-State Track

- 1. 3 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”**
- 2. All-State selections are determined to be the first place winners in each event (boys & girls) in each state class meet.**
- 3. The boys and girls All-State Indoor Track Teams will be honored together at a banquet.**

All-State Gymnastics

- 1. 3 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”**
- 2. Each division has four events**
- 3. All-State in gymnastics will be the top 8 places in each event in the state meet in each division. If an all around winner is different that the eight place winners in that division than that person would be added as an All-State individual**

All-State Baseball

1. **4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
2. **A total of fifteen players are selected by position in each division by all coaches.**
3. **All ballots are returned to All-State chairperson and the committee tabulates the votes.**
4. **There are 10 players selected on an all academic baseball team (separated from the above players)**

All-State Softball

1. **4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
2. **A total of fifteen players are selected by positions in each division by all coaches.**
3. **All ballots are returned to All-State chairperson and the committee tabulates the votes.**

Boys and Girls All-State Track

1. **5 divisions: “S”, “M”, “MM”, “L”, “LL”**
2. **All-State selections are determined to be the first place winners in each event in their state class meets.**

Boys and Girls All-State Golf

1. **The average of the golfer’s best 10 scores during the year minus course rating makes up 70% of the calculations.**
2. **The remaining 30% is the golfer’s score over/under par in the state tournament.**
(average of best 10 differentials times 70 + state tournament score – par times 30 = Rating number)
3. **For Boys to be nominated we require that they have an average of 5.0 or lower seasonal average differential. This the figure required for any individual to qualify for state tournament as an individual**
4. **Girls have a somewhat higher average requirement.**
5. **For the boys, the top 10 in each of the four divisions are selected.**
6. **For girls the top 12 are selected.**

Boys All-State Tennis

- 1. 4 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”, “LL”**
- 2. The All-State players will be semi-finalist in singles and finalists in doubles. There would be eight in each division.**

Girls All-State Tennis

- 1. 3 divisions: “S”, “M”, “L”**
- 2. The All-State players will be the final 16 in singles and the final eight doubles teams from all three divisions.**

Boys All-State Lacrosse

- 1. 3 divisions: Division I, Division II, Division III**
- 2. a. Coaches submit nominations to All-State committee.
b. Ballots go out to coaches in that division.
c. You cannot vote for your player.
d. Return the ballot to your All-State chairperson.
e. Winners are based on total number of points.**
- 3. a. All-State teams will now read 15 players in each division.
b. A total of 15 players of which you must have 1 goalie, 2 attack men, 3 defense men and 3 midfielders.**
- 4. Ballots will be returned to the Lacrosse Chairperson and the committee will tabulate all ballots and announce the winners.**

Girls All-State Lacrosse

- 1. 2 divisions: Division I, Division II**
- 2. Approximately 12 players, (natural break) will be on the first team**
- 3. Each coach nominates 16 players, 3 of which can be from the nominating coach’s school in the appropriate division.**
- 4. Four votes must be for defenders and one vote for a goalie.**
